Modified Visitation for FMC Butner Due to COVID-19

Effective Saturday, October 3, 2020, visitation at the Federal Medical Center, Butner, North Carolina, will resume. In order to mitigate the potential spread of COVID-19, multiple changes have been enacted to ensure the safety and health of the inmate population, staff and the public.

All inmates will be afforded an opportunity for two separate one-hour visits per month. It is important you adhere to the time frames for visiting provided to you by the inmate. No extensions will be granted so please be on time. Each inmate must contact their Unit Team in order to pre-schedule each visit. Due to physical barriers that have been put in place in the visitation area, all visits will be non-contact visits, and will be limited in the number of visits that can occur during any one-hour visitation period. Additionally, each visit is limited to no more than two people per inmate.

If you would like to visit an inmate housed at the Federal Medical Center, please contact the inmate directly to have the inmate schedule a visit. You must be on the inmate's approved visiting list. The inmate will advise if you have been placed on his visiting list and if you are approved for the scheduled visit. Please do not visit the facility if you have not been informed of your approval to visit by the inmate. You will not be allowed to enter the facility.

Visitors must arrive no later than 30 minutes prior to scheduled visits. All visitors will be required to go through the health screening site located in the FMC parking lot. Visitors will be symptom screened and temperature checked prior to entry into the facility. All visitors who clear the screening site will be issued a wristband. You are required to wear the wristband during the entire visit. Visitors who are sick or symptomatic will be denied entry.


Ten visitors will be authorized in the Front Lobby area at one time. Visitors will be phased into the visitation room by staff escort in groups of four. Inmates will be in-processed in conjunction with their specific visitor(s). Inmates and visitors will wear face coverings at all times and perform hand hygiene before and after visits. Bandanas and neck gaiters will not be authorized.

Photographs will not be conducted. Food and beverages are not authorized; however, special provisions for baby formula/food will be authorized on a case by case basis. Upon the conclusion of visiting, visitors and inmates will be phased out in the same manner as entry.

The visitation area will be sanitized between each visiting block.

Please do not contact the facility directly to be scheduled for visitation. Scheduling will only occur upon the request of the inmate and approval of Unit Team.

Please note, all visiting rules and regulations as outlined in Institution Supplement BUH 5267.09.03A: Visiting Regulations, will continue to apply during these modified visitation procedures. Thank you for your cooperation.

HEALTH SCREENING SITE

ALL VISITORS

ENTER THE MAIN ENTRANCE OF THE FEDERAL MEDICAL CENTER (FMC).
DRIVE STRAIGHT TOWARD THE INSTITUTION AND TURN RIGHT (AS SHOWN IN THE DIAGRAM) TO THE SCREENING SITE.

AFTER CLEARING THE HEALTH SCREENING, RETURN TO OLD OXFORD ROAD (HWY 75) TO GAIN ENTRANCE TO THE LSCI.

YOU WILL BE ISSUED AN ARM BAND TO GAIN ENTRANCE TO THE RESPECTIVE INSTITUTION YOU ARE VISITING. THIS ARM BAND WILL BE GOOD FOR THAT DAY ONLY.
